How to Build a Log Cabin (...from Scratch and by Hand)

First, lay the tanalised floor spars/bearers into position with a 400mm centred spacing as shown in your build diagram. Place the first row of logs around and screw into position - Make sure the floor is square at this point by measuring corner to corner, then lay the floor boards leaving a 5mm spacing for expansion - nail each floor board with the 40mm nails and continue to the end, the last board may need to be cut.
