In 1938, 3 members of the Windsor Yacht Club travelled to Detroit to attend the Elementary Piloting (now Boating) class at the Detroit Squadron of the United States Power Squadron (USPS). After completing the course they decided that Canada needed an organization offering similar safe boating courses and the Windsor Squadron was born.

The group applied and the official launch of the Nanaimo Squadron took place on April 12, 1957. Ours was the first Squadron on Vancouver Island and the 3rd in British Columbia. Since those humble beginnings, the Nanaimo Power & Sail Squadron has provided training for thousands of boaters.
