In portrait photography, there are some standard guides for the ' crop ', or 'frame' of a portrait. This is important, because the crop can affect the pose. The standard guides are: the headshot, head and shoulders shot, half body shot, three quarter body shot, full body shot, and a group photo. These are all pretty self-explanatory.
